Formal educational programs designed to enhance clinical competence and improve patient care, and must be sponsored by an AOA accredited Category 1 CME sponsor (UNECOM) including:

A. F2F CME

(consists of formal face-to-face conferences, seminars and workshops – must meet 50%)

B. Opioid Management

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- Sponsored by AOA-Accredited Category 1 CME sponsors that do not meet the 1-A faculty/hours requirement for Category 1-A credit. (i.e. Risk Management Programs that are clinical in nature, but do not meet the 1-A faculty/hours requirement; are sponsored by an ACCME-accredited organization; or an AAFP-approved program.

H. Test Construction, Committee Work

A. Formal:

- i. Test construction committee work will be awarded Category 1-B credit when performed as part of a seminar, meeting of an AOA official certifying board, or an AOA practice affiliate's postgraduate in-service examination committee, or at a meeting of the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners with at least three attendees.

B. Informal:

- i. One Category 1-B credit will be awarded for each test item written, with a maximum of ten credits per CME
